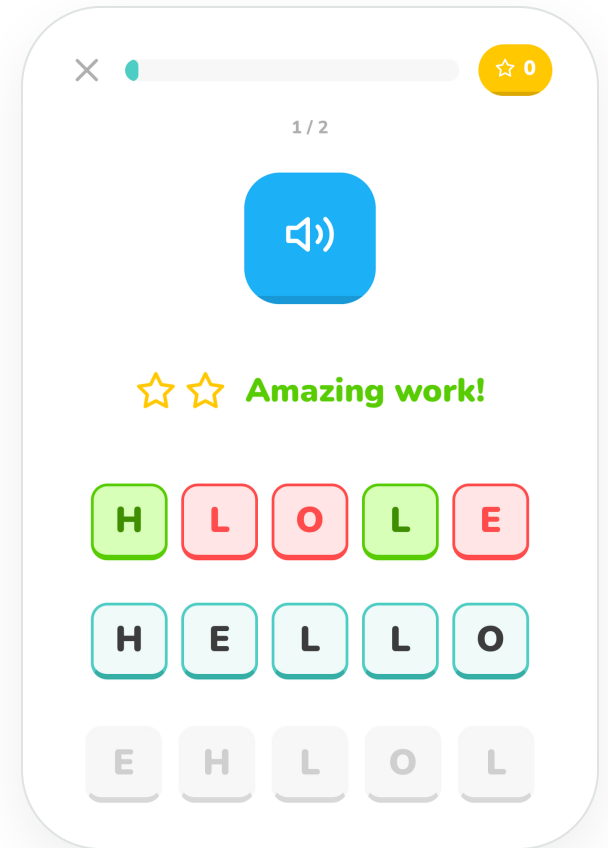

The teacher sees who is ready and which words need one more look.

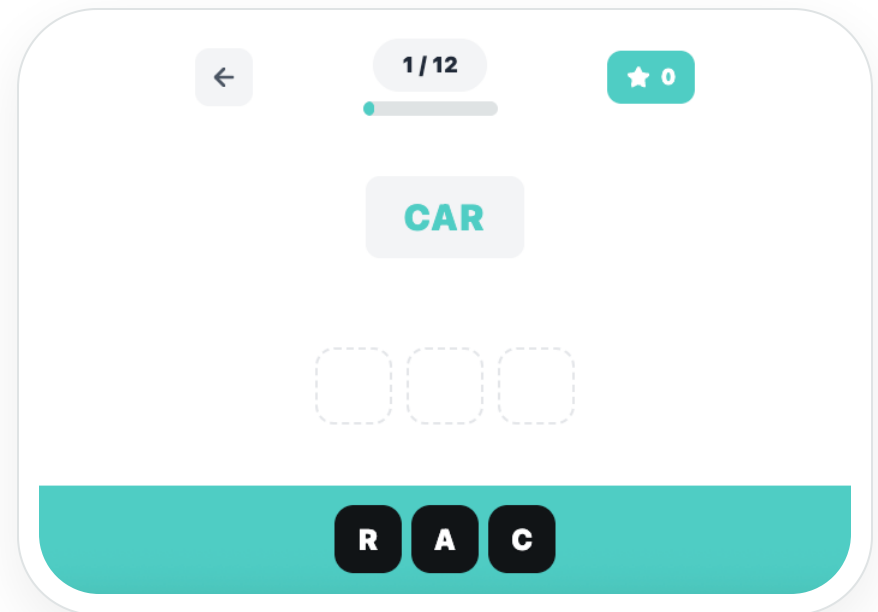

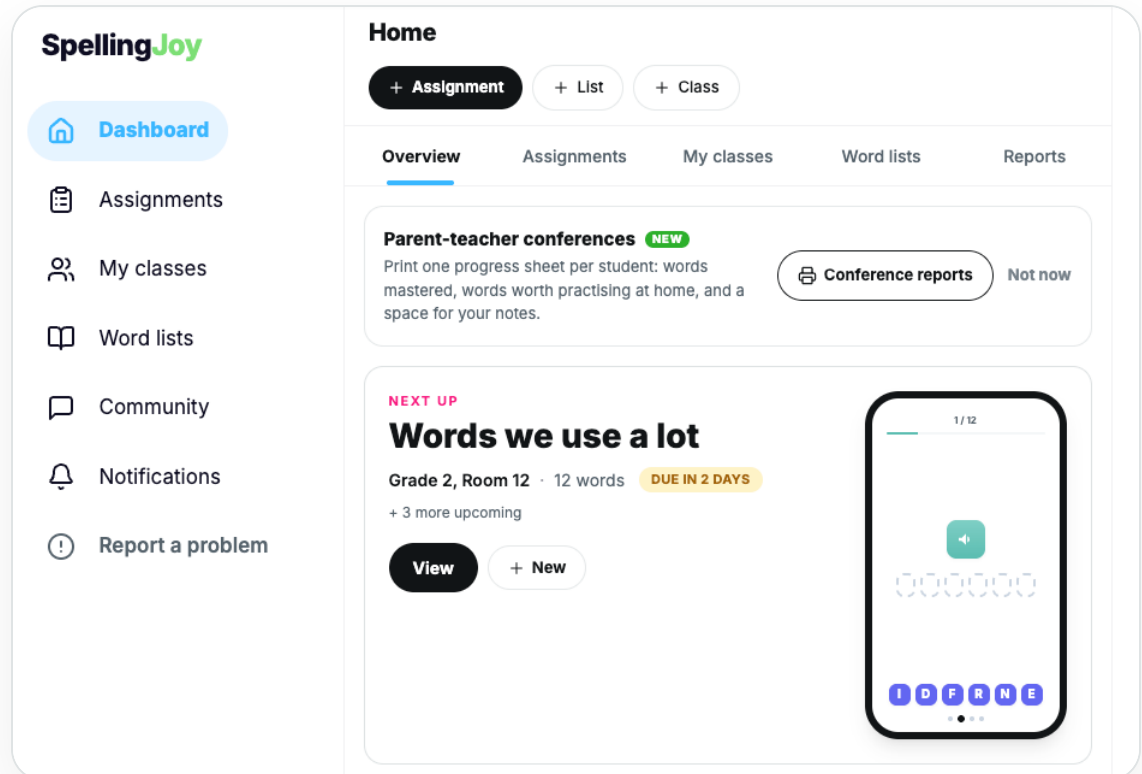
